Minutes General Assembly 10 May 2014

After the last session of the 11th EURAMAL conference in Madrid (7th to the 10th of May 2014), the General Assembly of EURAMAL was held. The meeting was opened at 12:00 by the president, Isabella Camera D'Afflitto, in presence of all the members of the Bureau, in Madrid, fascilities of the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, 10th of May 2014

I - Financial situation

The treasurer of EURAMAL, Elisabeth A. Moestrup, reported that EURAMAL funds, by May 6th 2014, before collection of the latest EURAMAL registration fee (2014-2016), stood at € 2316,74.

II - Report of the president (2012-2014), Isabella Camera D'Afflitto

- The president informed the assembly that the Bureau had agreed in the meeting held in Rome in May 2013 to start conversations with the International Prize for Arabic Fiction (IPAF) in order to explore the possibilities of collaboration for this conference and for the future, given the shared goals and affinities of both institutions. Although it had not yet officially confirmed by IPAF, the president announced that the collaboration would start from the Madrid conference.
- The proceedings of the Rome Euramal Conference have just been published and brought to the conference.
- A new website independent from our own universities, in an "EU" domain http://www.euramal.eu/ has been created in order to ensure continuity, irrespective of any future change of the Bureau composition. The president will transfer all the details and codes to the new President.
- In the Bureau's last meeting, and without changing any rules of the Constitution, it has been decided that the elections will be supervised by an electoral college, composed of the Secretary General and two members. For the first time the Bureau will be elected on the basis of a secret ballot. Only the members whose memberships are up to date, are entitled to vote. Proxy voting is not admitted.
- A procedure for voting through ballot has been established. The ballot includes spaces to designate the
 president, secretary general, treasurer and two members (not three, as was usual, since the constitution
 specifies only two). It was decided also that the former president remains as guest member to give
 continuity to EURAMAL activities
- Given complications experienced in the past two years with banking, the president recommends that
 future treasurers be chosen from among members within the Euro zone, also because this will be a more
 economical option for our budget.
- In order to guarantee continuity in the administration of Euramal, it is proposed that the outgoing Euramal President become an ex officio member of the new Executive Bureau, in addition to the elected members.
- The president warmly thanked all members of the Bureau.

III - Elections

Secretary General and two members, Ada Barbaro and Francisco Rodríguez Sierra, constitute the electoral college.

After some discussion on procedure, nominations for the new Bureau were made by the membership present and accepted by the nominees.

The only candidate for president, Sobhi Boustani, obtained 25 votes out of 28.

The only candidate for secretary general, Stephan Guth, obtained 25 votes out of 28.

The only candidate for treasurer Paola Viviani, obtained 27 out of 28.

The two members elected for receiving more votes are Rasheed El-Enany (21) and Tania Al Saadi (16), and not elected Ulrike Stehli-Werbeck (10) and Tetz Rooke (6).
